POSITION TITLE: General Contractor

EMPLOYMENT TYPE: Part or Full time (1-2 homes renovated per year)

UNIT ORGANIZATION: Community Impact

REPORTS TO: Improve Norwich Now, Anonymous Funder

PURPOSE OF POSITION:

The primary role of the General Contractor (GC) is to oversee an Improve Norwich Now initiative to rehabilitate single family homes in Norwich. It will be essential for the GC to coordinate local contractors, plumbers, electricians, artisans, and construction supply companies in order to build a team who can be called upon to participate as members of this Improve Norwich Now initiative. Furthermore, the GC will need to work cooperatively with the I.N.N. Housing Team members in order to coordinate all aspects of the project (from purchase to sale of the home).

As a member of the Improve Norwich Now (I.N.N.) team, the GC will assist ongoing I.N.N. efforts, along with potentially volunteering time towards I.N.N. board meetings and events. It will be the expectation of the Board to receive monthly updates (at minimum) from the GC.

KEY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Develop clear, concise work plan proposals for the rehabilitation of homes, including labor, materials, and overall price estimates
- Coordinate all work being done on the home
- Maintain effective communication with all parties involved
- Leverage existing services to meet needs as they surface
- Be prepared to attend I.N.N. Community meetings and Board meetings (upon request)

Confidentiality/Discretion

Confidentiality and discretion are needed. Building trusting relationships with our funding source and local service providers is essential.

- A strong background in quality construction skills (it is possible the GC may elect to provide the contractor skills required to complete renovations to the home)
- A preferred background in flipping/renovating homes, especially in Chenango County
- The ability to effectively manage information (project oversight)
- Communication skills: excellent listening skills and effective speaking skills. This
 includes the ability to communicate in an approachable and understandable way for
 diverse audiences.
- An awareness of community engagement is preferred
- Ability to adapt to unforeseen issues that may arise at any point during the process
- Organization skills are necessary to manage estimates, expenses, and track against available funds
- Knowledge of local community partners
- Demonstrated neutrality, objectivity, professionalism, problem solving, confidentiality, and calmness under pressure in a work setting

- Valid driver's license and personal transportation.
- Must be willing to travel throughout Norwich to attend various meetings with entities involved in the process (purchase to sale of the home)
